INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PLANS

In the coming 2 weeks teachers will be contacting you to arrange time to meet with you to develop your child's 2024 Individual Education Plan.

ATTENDANCE

All students are required to be enrolled and attending school every school day unless they are sick or have an exemption from school which has been authorized by the Director Educational Leadership. Our Student Support Officer, psychologist and staff are available to assist you in helping to improve your child's attendance.

There will be Attendance Excursions each term for students with attendance rates above 85% or whose attendance has improved significantly. <u>Attendance Matters</u>.

POINTS

It was great to be able to see students being rewarded for their efforts today. Remember students can achieve a maximum of 160 points in a day and 800 points in a week. When students achieve 4000 points they will be provided with a gift card.

In general, 100 points in a day indicates that the student has been completing class work and working well towards their goals of being Kind, being Safe and trying to be their best. Teachers will be providing daily updates by email on your child's progress. Your email will have information about how many points were achieved, something your child did well and something they can focus on the next day.

UNIFORMS

Carinya is a uniform school. The students looked fantastic in their uniforms today. If you need new uniforms please contact the office. Please note we have school caps to keep the sun off faces during our breaks.

DRINK BOTTLES
