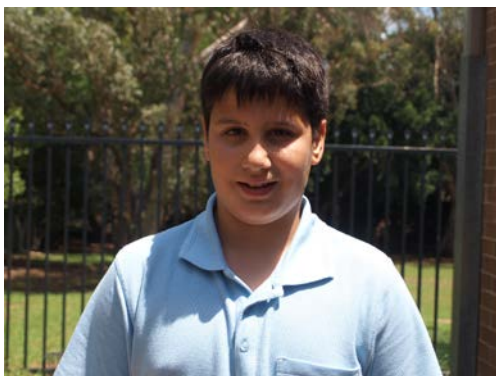
Sport

Anti Bullying at Carinya School



This term students have been learning about Bullying in their PH/H/PE lessons and by watching film clips and skits performed at assembly. Bullying is defined as any behaviour that tries to hurt or intimidate another person and that is ongoing (it happens more than once or twice-it's not an accident). Bullying can be verbal, physical or cyber and involves someone trying to be more powerful than someone else. We have been learning how bullying usually happens away from teachers and how important it is for bystanders to speak up and say something to the bully and to help the victim. 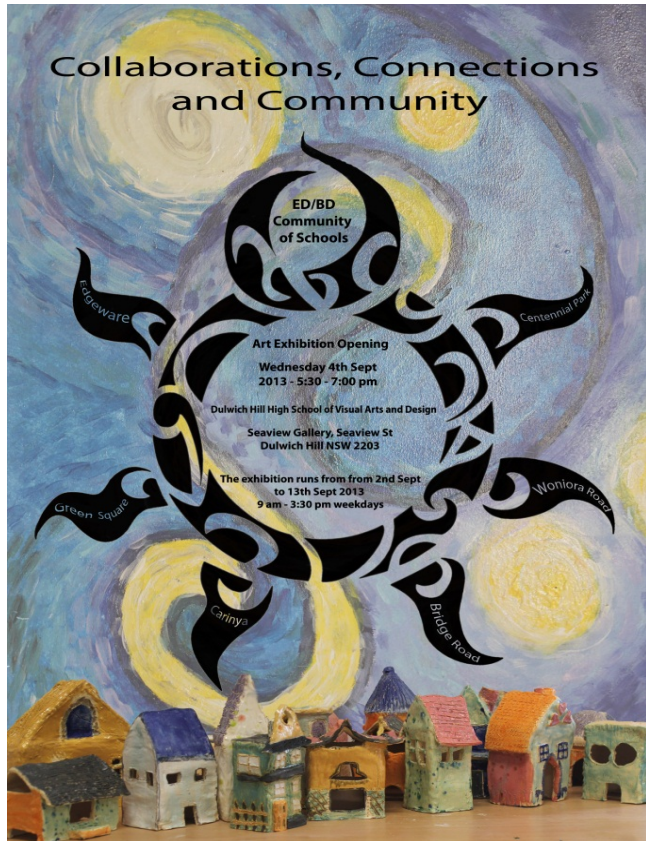
